This locally administered, federal aid streetscape improvement project involves streetscape improvements of approximately 1.12 miles along County Road 23B (Jefferson Heights), from Fairview Avenue to Austin Acres in the Town of Catskill, Greene County. The aim of this project is to improve pedestrian and bicycle safety while enhancing a “downtown” feel of the Town.

Scope of work includes scoping, preliminary and final design services. Proposed improvements to the street will include:

- Milling and overlay of existing pavement materials.
- Installing new granite curbing adjacent to the sidewalk.
- Enhancing pedestrian and bicycle safety which includes high visibility crosswalks with stamped and colored asphalt surface.
- Installing new five foot wide ADA accessible sidewalks as well as a parallel multi-use path.
- Designing a pocket park that will include: wrought iron railing, landscaping, lighting, benches, and signage.
- Adding decorative landscaping and street lighting fixtures.
- Re-using brick pavers to maintain the character of the road.
- Designing lighting similar to existing fixtures on the lower section of the project area.
- Providing steel woven benches along the sidewalk and trail.
